AP sources: Kaine to cut \$1.3 billion

RICHMOND — Gov. Timothy M. Kaine will cut the state's cash-strapped budget by about \$1.3 billion in an address today before legislative budget writers, legislators told The Associated Press.

His address to members of the House and Senate money committees will mark the fourth time since September that the governor has been forced by the worst economy since the 1930s to scale back state spending.

[Trial set in triple slaying](#)

The trial of an 18-year-old who has been alleged to be the triggerman in a triple slaying has been scheduled for December.

Carl DeShawn Turner, whose last address was 935 Blankenship Road, Martinsville, has been indicted on first-degree murder charges in the deaths of Martin Cardecas and Rafael Torres Sanchez. He also has been indicted on felony murder — a lesser charge — in the deaths of Cardecas, Sanchez and a third man, Gabriel Rene Rogel-Mirafuentes.


